

Sureyya S. Dikmen, Ph.D.

Dr. Dikmen is a professor in the Department of Rehabilitation Medicine and adjunct professor in the Departments of Neurological Surgery and Psychiatry and Behavioral Science at the University of Washington. She has devoted her career as a neuropsychologist to the study of TBI with emphasis on the natural history of recovery and clinical trials to reduce the negative impacts of these injuries. The clinical trials have included acute trials to prevent post-traumatic seizures and neuroprotection trials to improve overall outcome. Post-acute behavioral intervention trials have been aimed at improving functional status and quality of life following TBI. She has been on multiple TBI expert working groups, scientific advisory boards and data and safety monitoring boards for CDC, NINDS, NIDRR, DOD, the Brain Injury Association of America, and Institute of Medicine.
